Privacy Policy

Human Metabolome Technologies Inc. ("the Company") collects data relating to privacy from the persons visiting the Company's website over the Internet. The Company recognizes the importance of personal data of individuals and makes every effort to protect personal data as set forth below.

1. Collection and Use

The Company shall process the request once the Company has confirmed that the request came from the user. Please note that the user is responsible for the cost of postage and other related expenses.
